#### **TGIS (Thank God It's Sunday)**

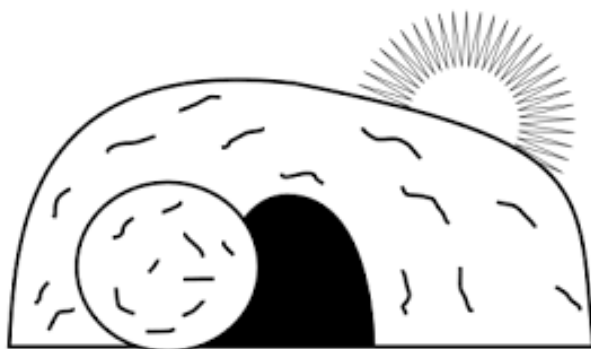
